


The Display

The Display is where the user can make the computer Desktop and Windows look how they want.. There are 2 ways to get to this area.

The First, is using the Control Panel. This is done by doing the following commands.

START, SETTINGS, CONTROL PANEL




Look for this Icon in the control panel and double click on that Icon.


The other way is though a short cut

Choose PROPERTIES.




Either of these ways are correct and both will open the Display Window

The Display




This is where a image or a web page can be used as a wallpaper. It will always show when the computer is started.

If it is a web page then it will only show when the computer is connected to the web





A screen saver is a moving picture or pattern that appears on your screen when the computer has not been used for a number of minutes. The user can decide how long that time is.




This is the way to control how the windows look on the desktop. Each item is possible to change. Click on a item that you want to and possible choices will appear in the area below.

After changes have been made it can be saved in case something changes it. To save the changes under a scheme click the saves as.





This is more for computers that are connected to the web all the time. This area lets the user make the desktop look like a web page.




This is the area that allows the changing of special icons.

The selections in the *Visual Effect* area make small changes in the things the user sees.


They will be discussed.

If the effect is forgotten what it does. Make a selection click the apply button. Then test on the Desktop and see what happens. If not liked the unselect, click apply and it will return to what it was like before.



This area permits the changing of the screen it self. Such as Resolution(how sharp the computer screen is) and how good it shows color.

Notice the Advanced button in the bottom right corner. There is a couple of setting in this area the user needs to know about.




Most of the time there will be 6 tabs here. General, Adapter, Monitor, Troubleshooting, Color Management, (Kind of Video card).


The instructors Computer is show.. and he has a Geforce Video card.

The Tab that a new user needs to know about is the General tab. This area will control the size of the letters (fonts) on the computer screen. If there are problems reading the screen.

The other 5 tabs as new users are not necessary to explain. However in class they will be shown.



Change the fonts to Large fonts. This setting makes them bigger. If the large font setting is to big then the last choice gives the user a way to control exactly what size they want



In the Other Font size area. When the choice is made a slide bar appears and can be adjusted to make what ever size font is wanted.

The change is shown below the scale.

Compatibility:

In the bottom area there are radio buttons.

These buttons let the user decide if the computer needs to restart before settings are changes.

HINT: Most of the time you do not need to restart the computer for the changes to work correctly
